**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education approves the following:

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Education Law §3811 and/or Public Officer’s Law §18, as well as under any other applicable legal or insurance policy provisions, board member Robert Feliciano has submitted a timely written request for legal defense and indemnification regarding a complaint to the Suffolk County Human Rights Commission entitled, *William Moss v. Brentwood Union Free School District*, dated on or about May 23, 2018 (the “legal action”); and

**WHEREAS**, there are allegations in the above-mentioned legal action arising from the performance of Robert Feliciano’s exercise of his official duties and responsibilities as Board President; and

**WHEREAS**, Robert Feliciano’s request for legal defense and indemnification is made both on behalf of himself as an individual board member and on behalf of the entire Board of Education; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education is aware that the above-mentioned legal action contains allegations against board attorney Candace J. Gomez, Esq. of the law firm of Bond, Schoeneck & King, PLLC; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education consents to waive any potential conflicts that may arise as a result of Bond, Schoeneck & King’s representation of the Board of Education in the above-mentioned legal action; and
