

GREAT SOUTH BAY YMCA Dr. Gene Schmidt Scholarship Award Selection Criteria

The award will be presented each year to a high school senior, one from Bay Shore High School and one from another local school or school district, who has maintained satisfactory grades with a minimum grade point average of 3.0 or a B average and displays an exemplary record of community service, leadership and/or employment.

Community service may include, but is not limited to, volunteerism with local government, community affairs, health issues, environmental concerns, or senior citizen or youth organizations.

**Please note: members of the Board of Managers, members of the Dr. Gene Schmidt Scholarship Committee, staff of the Great South Bay YMCA, and immediate family members of each of the above are not eliqible for this scholarship.

In order to be considered, the school district must submit completed applications for a maximum of five (5) candidates no later than April 17, 2017.

An official transcript with GPA is required with each application. Two (2) endorsements, one from an educator and one from another responsible adult involved with community service, are also required. Qualifying community service must be for a period of at least 12 months. An outstanding activity with a time commitment of less than 12 months may also qualify with the endorsement of at least two supervising adults. References may come from a teacher, counselor, extra curricular advisor, employer or a supervising adult.

The \$1,000 scholarship award may be used by the recipient for any educational purpose such as tuition, books, research project, etc.

Applications will be reviewed by a YMCA committee. The following criteria will be evaluated, with community service given the highest priority:

- 1. Community service record
- 2. Academic performance
- 3. Strength of Personal Statement
- 4. Financial need

A representative from Great South Bay YMCA will notify your school guidance department if a scholarship recipient is chosen from your district.
