New Information You Need to Know

What is the Minimum Job Corps Criteria?

- *The individual must be of low income, ages 18 and older are of their own income, minor family income
- *The individual should fall between the ages of 16 to 24 (must be enrolled prior to 25)
- *The individual will attend and orientation and must pass an interview to be accepted

How Do I Identify a Good Job Corps Candidate who is between 16 & 24

- *An individual who desires training after graduating from high school or has a GED
- *An individual who has educational and training needs that are not met by traditional high school
- *Individuals who have few credits and are unlikely to graduate on their current educational path
- *Individuals who are motivated to success and can achieve it with the guidance of Job Corps
- *Individual of low income that would like training in a residential setting – 18 and older is their own income

What is the Enrollment Process?

- *First the individual attends an orientation as listed below
- *The interested individual has an interview which is scheduled at the orientation
- *Provided the interview goes well the individual and counselor choose a JC campus and the official application is completed

Job Corps operates 12 months a year with continuous enrollment as space becomes available. The training and everything we offer is **no cost** to the student or their family. I have attached our current trade offerings for your review and distribution to interested families and students. Individual must bring at least id for the orientation. To make an application the person will need birth certificate, social security card, green card if applicable, transcript- GED- or diploma, immunization record, and proof of 1 month of income or public assistance.
